

Rules and important information during COVID 19.

Before entering the childcare, childcare providers must measure the body temperature of each child. (This is an MSDE state requirement)

If for any reason your child cannot come to the childcare, please inform the director and leading teacher about the absence of your child by text message.

We ask everyone to strictly observe hygiene rules including regular hand washing. After any outside activities, childcare staff will be directing and reminding every child to wash their hands with warm water and soap.

If your child has any symptoms of illness, the childcare requires the child to stay at home with a parent until the symptoms are gone.

If your child is found to have any symptoms during daycare, we will be contacting you urgently. Therefore, please be prepared to pick up your child within one hour from the time you receive a phone call.

Due to today's circumstances, the daycare's policies must be very strict regarding any illnesses. The childcare providers will check children's body temperature a few times during the day; Parent cooperation and understanding on this matter is greatly appreciated

If any child or childcare staff is diagnosed with COVID-19, then the daycare will have to be temporarily closed to isolate everyone who was potentially exposed to this virus.

In addition, if any family member or someone the child regularly communicates with has symptoms of the illness or positive tests for Covid-19, please let director know immediately.

In the case that your Sunflower Childcare location temporarily closes due to COVID-19 exposure, the tuition will drop to 50%. If you aren't able to attend the child care due to own case of exposure or illness of COVID-19, you also will be charged only 50% of your weekly tuition. The proof of the positive test results must be provided.

Communication and honesty will be highly appreciated for maintaining health and well-being of everyone.
